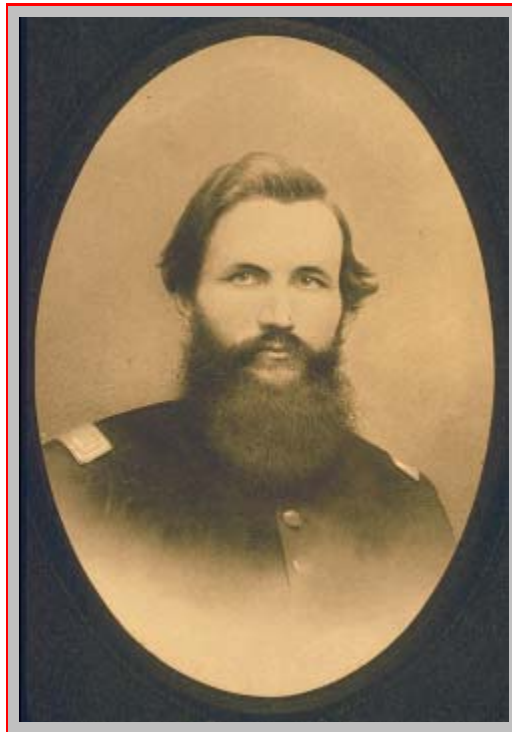

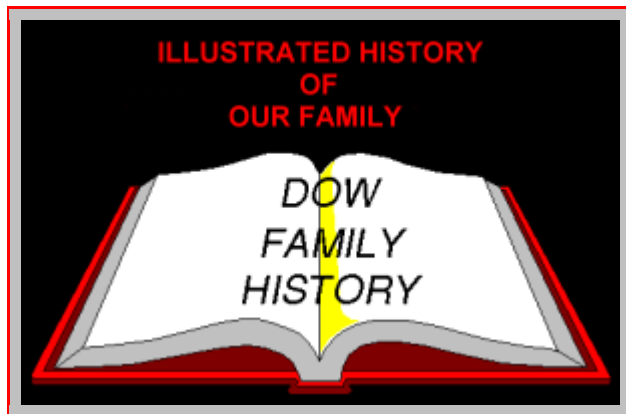

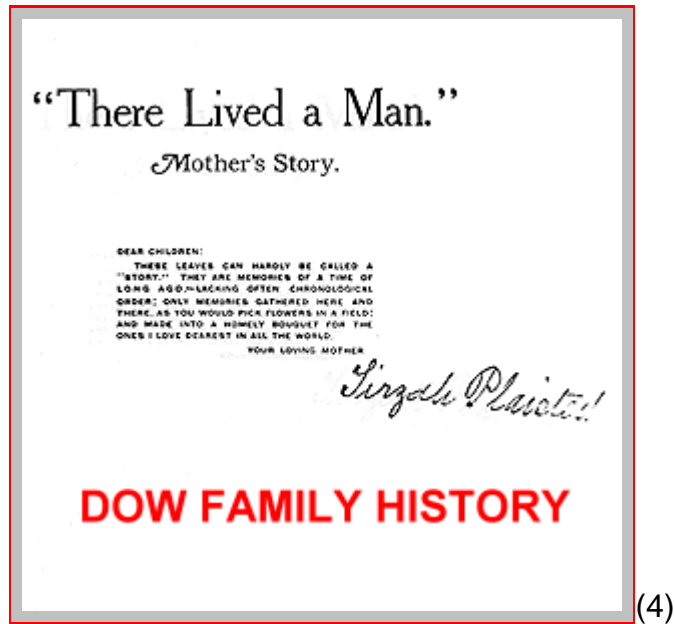

Among the few real family heirloom treasures I have in my possession are two of **Joseph Plaisted Jr.'s [RN1901]** original personal stone cutting tools. These were passed down by Joe Jr. to his son **Ralph Sargent Plaisted [RN1900]** and he passed them on to his son, **Ralph Davis Plaisted [RN 9]**.

In 1997, **Ralph Davis Plaisted [RN 9]** passed them on to me for preservation and safe keeping.

Each of these tools has his first name and last initial and the tool number stamped on it; "**Joe P 10**" and "**Joe P 19**". These are illustrated below in these pictures of the tools.



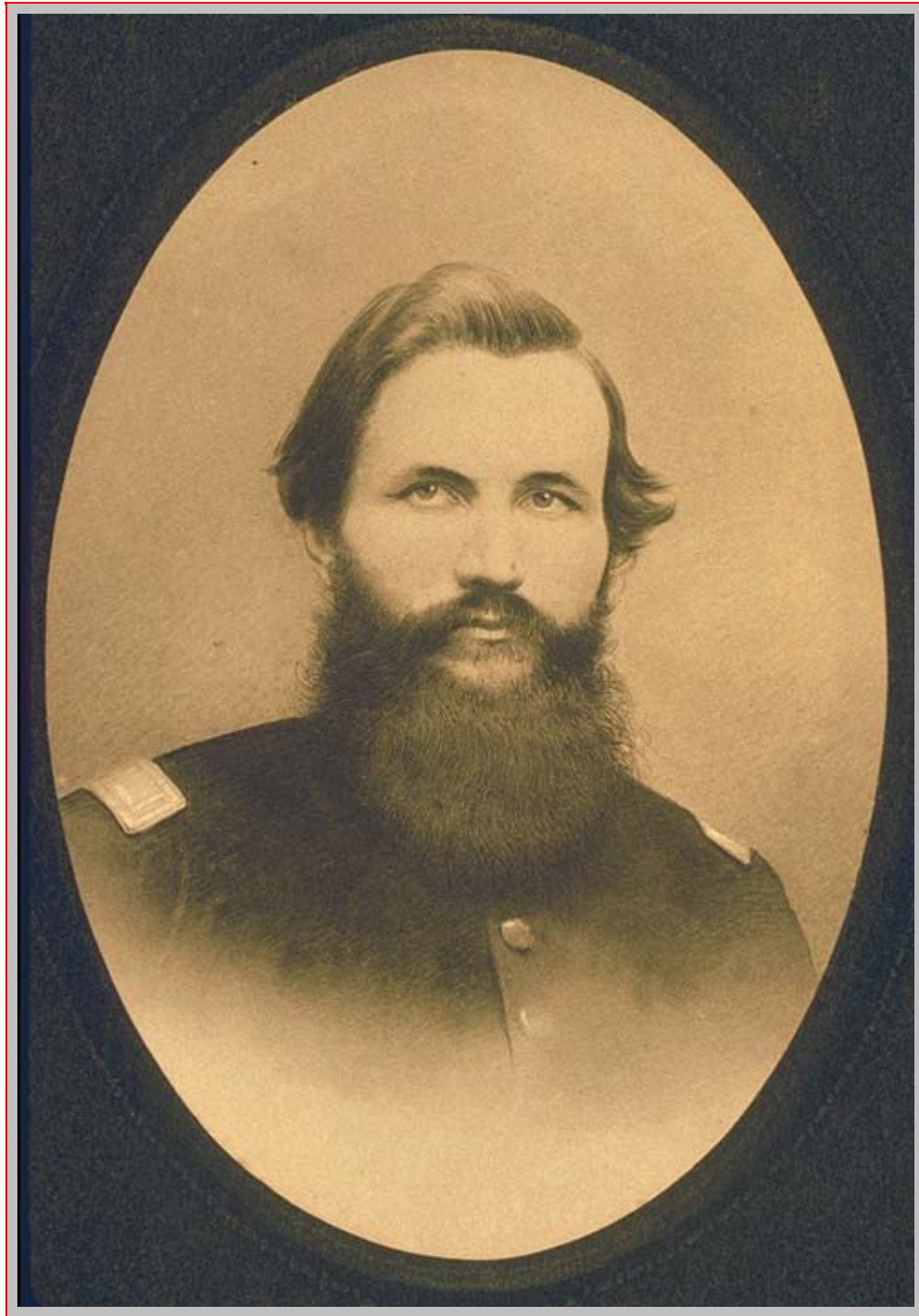

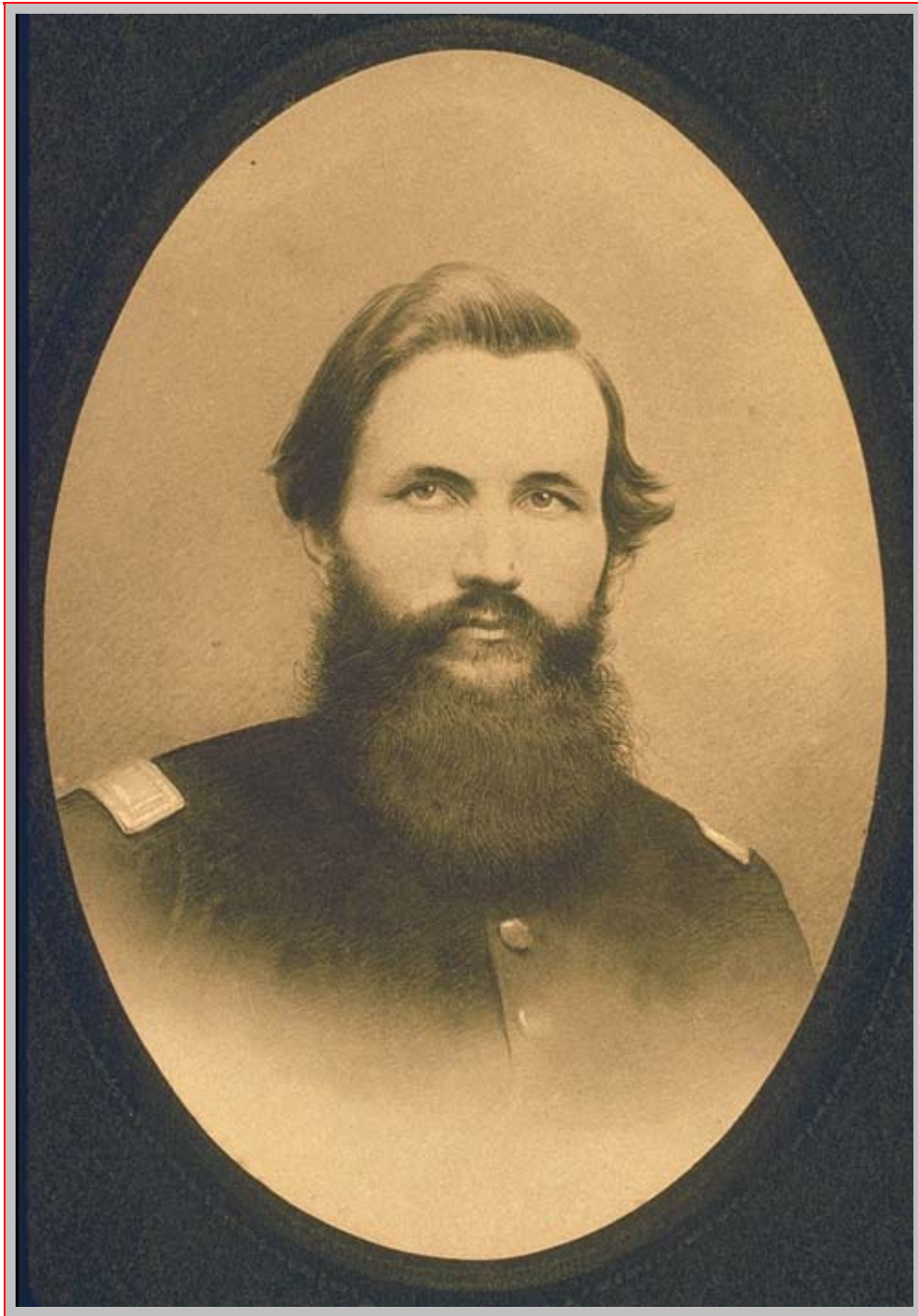

1 (Note)
